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Narrative:

On May 10th, at about 1757 hours, Partner Officer Castaneda and I were assigned to the Riverside Police Department METRO Team. We heard a radio call of shots fired at 11532 Trailway Drive, in the City of Riverside. We put ourselves en route to the radio call to assist Patrol Units. While en route, we heard an Officer on scene report additional shots fired and that the suspect was down. S-1 was described as a black male adult about forty (40) years-old and about 5' 10" tall. S-1 was described as wearing a white shirt and blue jeans.

Upon arrival to the location, I observed S-1 lying on the driveway in front of 11531 Trailway Drive. I identified S-1 from the description given by dispatch. Officers on scene also identified S-1 as having been armed with a handgun and involved in the shooting. S-1 was laying on his stomach and his head was pointed towards the residence at 11531 Trailway Drive. S-1's left hand was out of sight on the far side of his body. His right hand was concealed underneath his chest. S-1 was not responding to verbal commands. I could see S-1's chest was expanding and he displayed signs of labored breathing. I could see blood on the ground around S-1's head. Sgt. Corbett organized a team to approach the suspect to determine his condition and disarm him if necessary.

I approached S-1 on foot with the arrest team under Sgt. Corbett's supervision. Once beside S-1, I could see S-1 was holding both of his hands beneath his chest. I could see S-1 had an injury to his head. I holstered my handgun and put on latex gloves due to the presence of blood on and around S-1. The other Officers provided lethal cover while I completed the handcuffing. I crouched beside S-1 on his left hand side to place him in handcuffs. I could see a handgun underneath S-1's chest. I grabbed S-1's left hand and removed it from the handgun and placed it behind his back. I then grabbed S-1's right hand and placed it behind his back. I placed S-1 into handcuffs. For safety reasons, I removed the handgun from beneath S-1 and placed it several yards away on the west side of the driveway.

Sgt. Corbett organized a search team to look for additional subjects involved in the incident. I assisted Officers in searching 11532 Trailway Drive. Several occupants were removed from 11532 Trailway Drive during the search. I did not speak to any of these subjects.

I then moved to 11531 Trailway Drive with the search team. Five subjects exited 11531 Trailway Drive and followed the commands of the Officers outside. I then entered 11531 Trailway Drive with the search team. 11531 Trailway Drive was searched without incident.

I then returned 11532 Trailway Drive. Sgt. Corbett directed me to stay inside of the residence for scene security. Sgt. Corbett later relieved me. See additional Officer's reports for further.
