Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Riverside declaring that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Brockton Avenue, (formerly known as Eliza Street) in said City has been completed, and that the same is closed up and vacated.

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did on the 19th, day of January, 1926, pass its Resolution No. 859 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Brockton Avenue (Formerly known as Eliza Street) in said City, hereinafter described, as contemplated by resolution of Intention No. 825 (New Series) and

Whereas, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Brockton Avenue (formerly known as Eliza Street) has been done and completed:

Now therefore be it resolved, that the Common Council of the City of Riverside hereby declares that the portion of Brockton Avenue (formerly known as Eliza Street) in said City hereinafter described is closed up vacated as a public Street of the said City.

The portion of Brockton Avenue (formerly known as Eliza Street) hereinbefore referred to and affected by this Resolution is described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of lot 1, Block 7 of the Tibbetts Tract, as recorded in Book 2 of Maps, page 36, records of Riverside County, California; thence Southerly along the Easterly line of Lot 1, of said Block to the Northwesterly line of Magnolia Avenue; thence North-

easterly along the North westerly line of Magnolia Avenue to a point 20 feet Easterly from the Westerly line of Eliza Street, now known as Brockton Avenue; thence Northerly and parallel with the Easterly line of said lot 1 to the Southerly line of Central Avenue, thence Westerly along said Southerly line of Central Avenue, a distance of 20 feet to the point of beginning.

Also beginning at a point 339.21 feet Southerly from the center line of Central Avenue and 30 feet Easterly from the Westerly line of Eliza Street, as shown on the map of Tibbetts Tract, recorded in Book 2 of Maps, page 36, records of Riverside County, California; thence Southwesterly along the Southwasterly line of Magnolia Avenue, a distance of 40.71 feet to the point of beginning; thence on a curve coneave to the East, having a radius of 10 feet and 1520 24° of arc to a point/Easterly from the Westerly line of Eliza Street, now known as Brockton Avenue; thence Southerly and parallel with said center line to the Northerly line of the right of way of the Riverside Water Company's Canal; thence Northwesterly to the Southeast corner of lot 34, Block 7, said Tibbetts Tract,

Thence Northerly along the East line of said Block to the Southeasterly line of Magnolia Avenue: thence Northeasterly along the Southeasterly line of Magnolia Avenue to the point of beginning.
