A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 17295; RESERVING PERMANENT EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SANITARY SEWERS AND GAS LINE FACILITIES AND FOR AERIAL AND UNDERGROUND TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH AND COMMUNICATION FACILITIES, AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE THE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING CHARLES STREET, SITUATED NORTHWESTERLY OF LA CADENA DRIVE, NORTHERLY OF 60 POMONA FREEWAY.

WHEREAS on October 17, 1989, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 17295 declaring its intention to order the vacation of Charles Street, situated northwesterly of West La Cadena Drive and northerly of the 60 Pomona Freeway, and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law; and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the street ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use;

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26 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the street in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described in the document attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and by this reference made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby determine that the public convenience and necessity require the reservation of permanent easements and rights of way for sanitary sewers and gas line facilities, and reserving the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures, as may be applicable, for the operation of sanitary sewers and gas lines; and a permanent easement and right of way to construct, place, operate, inspect, maintain, repair, replace and remove such aerial and underground telephone, telegraph and communication structures as the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company may from time to time require consisting of poles, anchors, wires, cables, conduits, manholes, markers and necessary fixtures and appurtenances; including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and wood growth that would interfere with the use of said permanent easements and rights of way.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacation shall occur only after the applicable conditions contained in the Planning Department's report to the legislative body, and on file with

the City Clerk have been satisfied; and the City Clerk is hereby directed not to record this resolution of vacation until the applicable conditions have been satisfied.

ALSO RESERVING therefrom a permanent easement and right-ofway for aerial and underground telephone, telegraph and communication facilities;


