lesser interests and estates of said defendants therein, for the use, uses and purposes described and set forth in plaintiff's complaint, that is to say for the acquisition, construction, completion, operation and maintenance of a public utility and public improvement consisting of electric light, heat and power distribution and transmission lines in the City of Riverside and for all other purposes and uses authorized by the constitution and laws of the State of California and Charter of the City of Riverside, together with the right to enter upon all easements, rights of way and properties for the purpose of maintaining the said electrical transmission facilities.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said uses are public uses and uses authorized by law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that a copy of this order and judgment be filed in the office of the Recorder of the County of Riverside, State of California, and thereupon the property described in plaintiff's complaint and the title thereto shall vest in the plaintiff.
