Technical and Aviation Career Day Coming to Riverside Airport May 20

Event to feature career advice and technical career paths

RIVERSIDE, Calif. – High school students, recent graduates and anyone interested in a career change are invited to a Career Technical Education Fair at Riverside Municipal Airport on Saturday, May 20 to explore traditional and aviation careers, including pilot training, operations, technicians, machinists, and engineering.

The free event is scheduled for 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the airport, at 6951 Flight Road in Riverside.

Attendees will hear from flight schools located at the Riverside Municipal Airport as well as local universities and colleges that offer a range of specialized programs. Guest speakers will discuss career opportunities, vendors will have aviation-related merchandise available for purchase, and attendees will be able to observe training simulators and current training aircraft.

“Training and connecting skilled labor to high-demand jobs is the cornerstone of the Southern California Inland economy,” Mayor Rusty Bailey said. “Programs like those featured at the Aviation and Career Technical fair are accomplishing just that for a sustained and robust quality of life here in Riverside.”
