- Assign prosecutors into neighborhood police stations and community centers to ensure that they understand and can address the unique needs of our individual neighborhoods.

It focuses City resources on combatting community misdemeanors while allowing the District Attorney to focus on more violent crimes such as murders and rapes during a time in which his office remains understaffed and underfunded. It's a win-win for neighborhoods and crime victims.
