CPRC Officer Elections

Hill Officer-Involved Death (OID) Evaluation Process

Discussion and further action, if any, of the Commission's public report regarding the officer-involved death of Joseph Hill on October 19, 2006:

- A) Discussion of Stage III, Policy & Procedure Certification Process
- B) Discussion of Stage IV
- C) Discussion of Stage V

Discussion produced the following modifications to the March 11 fact sheet:

Addition of an item between #6 & 7:

Mr. Hill denied making a U-turn or not stopping at the stop sign.

Elimination of #29 by blending it with #27 and #28; they now read:

- 27) Ofcr. Adcox instructed Hill to sit on the curb with his legs extended in front of him.
- 28) Hill complied, but argued with the officers and accused them of harassment.

Commissioner Beeman:

- formally requested that public comment always be a part of CPRC meetings.

Commissioner Pearcy:

- concurred with Commissioner Beeman regarding public comment
- requested that the Chair, on behalf of the Commission, send a letter to the Governmental Affairs Committee stating that "the CPRC has never discussed nor requested that its investigators be able to participate in any active crime scene as part of its officer-involved death investigations."

Commissioner Beeman asked that a discussion regarding the process of drafting public reports be agendized.

Commissioner Ward asked that a discussion regarding the role of the CPRC manager be agendized.
