Narrative of Supplemental Report:

On 09-01-08, I responded to 5807 Yarborough, regarding a report of shots fired from officers who had responded to the location regarding a subject with a gun. I arrived on scene and ensured the location was secure by assigning units to block off the street and make sure the citizens in the area were not in harms way.

I also spoke talked to Officer J. Munoz and J. Heiting who were involved in the shooting. I told them that they were going to be separated and an officer of their choice would accompany them back to the station. I also asked Officer Munoz and Officer Heiting only questions regarding public safety and scene security. I relayed that information to Lieutenant D. Hurt at the scene.

Officer Munoz said he thought he fired 4-5 rounds towards the north toward the suspect. He said there was a truck that was north of his location that had a messed up tailgate, and that was the direction the rounds traveled. He also said the only other potential suspect might be a male Hispanic, with a shaved head, several tattoos and wearing a blue shirt. He said that was the subject that was extremely uncooperative.

Officer Heiting said he thought he fired one round toward the suspect. In the event the round did not strike the suspect, he though the round would have traveled to the north, but would have struck the asphalt or concrete of the sidewalk, based on the trajectory.
