62. Narrative of Supplemental Report. On 09-01-08 at about 2000 hrs., partner Officer Hammer and I responded to a shots fired broadcast and 11-99 at 5807 Yarborough. We responded from the 91 freeway and Madison Ave. Upon arrival, Officer Hammer and I assisted with containment of several involved subjects inside the garage. As the occupants were called out of the garage, I assisted with handcuffing and securing the subjects. Officer Hammer and I were assigned to contain the rear of the house after the occupants in the garage were removed and secured. We contained the rear (east) and south sides of the house from the neighbor's backyard (5775 Yarborough). After the residence was secured, we were relieved from our containment positions. I spoke with W/Flores at 5775 Yarborough. Flores told me that he heard a lot of yelling and commotion outside. He walked outside and saw several males arguing. One of the males looked at Flores and told him to mind his own business and go back inside. Flores went inside and called the police regarding the disturbance.
