62. Narrative of Supplemental Report											
<p>On September 9, 2008, I conducted limited technical inspections of two Glock model 22 pistols and accompanying ammunition, magazines, and pistol-mounted flashlights at the request of Detective Steve Shumway. A limited technical inspection consists of a field-strip level disassembly (not a complete armorer's disassembly), inspection of the parts thus exposed, reassembly, and finally, a function test of the various operating systems of the firearm per factory guidelines.</p> <p>The first pistol (Item E1) has a serial number of [REDACTED] and was issued to Officer Juan Munoz. This pistol came to me [REDACTED] that I verified to be Winchester RA40T (RPD's duty round). Upon inspection under Glock factory guidelines, I found this pistol to be completely within factory specifications - as far as can be determined by the partial disassembly of a limited technical inspection - and this pistol successfully passed all of the Glock factory-recommended function checks. I tested the trigger pull of this pistol five times with a Lyman electronic trigger pull which</p>

recorded an average trigger pull-weight of seven pounds, seven and one-half ounces. Mounted to this pistol was a Streamlight model M3 flashlight, which was found to be in good working order with functional batteries.

The second pistol (Item E2) has a serial number of [REDACTED] and was issued to Officer James Heiting. This pistol came to me [REDACTED] that I verified to be Winchester RA40T (RPD's duty round). Upon inspection under Glock factory guidelines, I found this pistol to be completely within factory specifications - as far as can be determined by the partial disassembly of a limited technical inspection - and this pistol successfully passed all of the Glock factory-recommended function checks. I tested the trigger pull of this pistol five times with a Lyman electronic trigger pull which recorded an average trigger pull-weight of seven pounds, eight ounces. Mounted to this pistol was a Streamlight model TLR-1 flashlight, which was found to be in good working order with functional batteries.

Based on these inspections, neither pistol appears to contain any unauthorized aftermarket parts or modifications, and both appear to be in full working order. I see no reason that these firearms cannot be returned to service at the conclusion of this investigation.
