Additional Information:

The residence at 3468 Spruce Street, is a single story residence, on the south side of Spruce, facing north. The residence has a security screen on the front door.

The area of the Officer Involved Shooting, is dirt and gravel area west of the west sidewalk of Mulberry Street, south of 2883 Mulberry Street.

Narrative:

On January 17, 2009, at about 1756 hours, I responded to 3468 Spruce Street reference a subject with a gun call. The subject was identified by the reporting party as S/Hyatt.

The reporting party stated S/Hyatt was armed with a hand gun and pointed it at her.

A perimeter was established. I directed San Bernardino Sheriff's Department helicopter, 40 King, to our location. 40 King cleared the perimeter area with their forward looking infrared (FLIR). We received additional information S/Hyatt

may have fled to 3824 Spruce Street. Sergeant Whitt and Officer's Disla, Berretta, Miller and Russell responded to the location and conducted a search. S/Hyatt was not located. Once an extensive area check had been conducted, I had Officers Quinn and Russell remain near the residence in the event S/Hyatt returned. The remaining personnel cleared the scene at approximately 1906 hours. S/Hyatt was still outstanding.

At about 1937 hours, dispatch received another call. The caller advised S/Hyatt was back in the area. Officers Quinn Russell, Taylor and Miller located S/Hyatt walking southbound on Mulberry from Holding Street. At some point S/Hyatt produced a handgun. Officers continued to follow S/Hyatt. An Officer Involved Shooting occurred.

Investigative Actions:

I arrived on scene approximately 30 seconds to a minute after the shooting occurred. S/Hyatt was in a prone positioned and had been handcuffed. I confirmed medical aid had been requested. I identified Officer Taylor as the officer who had fired his duty weapon. I asked the Public Safety Questions (how many rounds were fired, what direction/trajectory and are there any outstanding suspects?). Officer Taylor told me he fired two rounds in a southwest direction, from where he (Officer Taylor) exited Officer Miller's patrol car. Officer Taylor said there were no outstanding suspect and that he (Officer Taylor) thought there was a handgun underneath S/Hyatt, near his waist area.

Based on the elevation where Officer Taylor was compared to the S/Hyatt and the direction the rounds were fired, it appeared two structures may potentially have been struck by a round fired. I directed Officers Russell and Quinn to check the abandoned residence that was on wood blocks, in the field area where the rounds may have traveled. Officers Quinn and Russell also checked a garage that backed up to the field area where the shooting occurred. There were no bullet strikes to either structure.

I directed the arriving units to take perimeter spots and secure the scene. Officer Baird was assigned to stay with and transport Officer Taylor to the Magnolia Station. Officer Hammer transported Officer Miller to the Magnolia Station and Officer Ratkovich transported Officer Russell to the Magnolia Station.

I remained on scene and assisted with notifications, ensuring the scene was secure and left once the Riverside Sheriff Coroner arrived and the scene was finished being process.
