62. Narrative of Supplemental Report
Background: I am currently assigned to the Riverside Police Department's Gang Intelligence Unit. I was called on my cell phone by Sergeant Banks and asked to respond to the area of Mulberry and 1st. An officer involved shooting had just occurred and I was asked to assist with any witness statements. I conducted an interview with [redacted] and audio taped the interview using Det. O'Boyle's recorder. The interview would later be downloaded into our system.
Narrative: I was assigned, along with Detective Turner and Detective O'Boyle, to meet with the family of the suspect at 68 Spruce St. At approx. 2230 hours we met Iris Hyatt and [redacted] Det. Turner began speaking with Iris Hyatt, while I met [redacted] in a back bedroom. Det. O'Boyle and I began talking with [redacted] and he told me the following:

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Synopsis of interview with W/1 Martin:

W/1 said he was playing a video game in the living room, when he heard his mom yelling outside and she said "Russell get out of the car", "what are you doing?" W/1 remembers his mom saying he's back from the program, and he's got a gun". He told his sister to lock the back door, but his sister met "Russell" as he was entering their house through the back door. W/1 said Russell went to his mom's room and he began going through dresser drawers and yelling that he wanted his keys and wallet. W/1 [REDACTED] said his sister had a friend over named "Jeff" and he told Russell to "calm down". Russell walked into the living room area and pointed a small gun towards his head, while he began counting. W/1 said he counted to 9 or 10 and then he walked outside. W/1 [REDACTED] described the gun as a silver and black gun. W/1 told me that Russell said "I'm going to shoot" while he was counting. W/1 continued to say that Russell exited the house by kicking their metal screen door, breaking the frame around the door. (I took several photographs of the damaged frame and screen.) W/1 [REDACTED]st saw Russell walking W/B Spruce St.

W/1 told me his mom married Russell about a year ago and he described their relationship as "OK". W/1 lives [REDACTED] W/1 said tonight Russell's breath was bad and it smelled like alcohol.

12 Q: (Unintelligible). All right. Can you (unintelligible) please? All right.  
13 [REDACTED] just basically from the beginning, (unintelligible) and  
14 everything. So from - from your - your own words, your perspective of  
15 what happened and start from the beginning and go ahead and tell me  
16 what happened.

17  
18 A2: Okay, um, I heard my mom say Russell is in the car. She told me yeah,  
19 that he (unintelligible) the program. And so I looked out the window  
20 after I told (Marketa) to go to the back door. Too late.

21  
22 Q: You told who?

23  
24 A2: (Marketa). And she um, was too late. And he was trying to already get  
25 in so she tried to stop him from getting in. And I said, watch out, he  
26 has a gun. And my mom just like, gets her little scared face on. She  
27 was scared I guess. And she went into the room and then she left and  
28 then she looked out. He came in asking for the keys. I want the keys.  
29 He started banging on stuff, swinging from left to right in the laundry  
30 room. Then he went into the um, living room and so he was saying, I  
31 don't care. I just want my keys. And ah, and my sister almost got into a  
32 tussle earlier like before that, though. And then Jeff was trying to tell  
33 him to calm down, just stop. You need to sit down and think for a  
34 minute. He's like no, I'm okay. So then um, I guess, I don't know what  
35 happened like it's kind of blurry.

36  
37 Q: So at this point he's already made it into the kitchen area?

38  
39 A2: Mm-hm.

40  
41 Q: Back by the kitchen area. Your sister and him get into a little tussle.  
42 You say, watch out, he's got a gun. You see the gun. And what color  
43 was - how could you describe the gun to us?

44  
45 A2: It was silver.

1  
2 Q: Silver?  
3  
4 A2: And black.  
5  
6 Q: Silver and black.  
7  
8 A2: He carried it like he walked - he stopped right there in the hall. It was  
9 pointing - the baby is like right there.  
10  
11 Q: Here?  
12  
13 A2: No, like in there.  
14  
15 Q: Okay.  
16  
17 A2: (Unintelligible) the couch, because my mom is sitting on the ground  
18 like don't do it.  
19  
20 Q: So he's walking around the living room with the gun to his head?  
21  
22 A2: Mm-hm.  
23  
24 Q: And what is he saying?  
25  
26 A2: I'm going to shoot. And he starts counting. I'm like if you're gonna do  
27 it, just do it. Why count? I know you're going to do something. And  
28 then after that two seconds later he kicks the black - I mean the black  
29 kind of gated door and messes up the door and was yelling at me and  
30 my mom.  
31  
32 Q: Mm-hm.  
33  
34 A2: And then he goes left. I look outside and (Marketa) is pushing me back  
35 in and I see the gun go like this. So I hurry up and pull my mom back.  
36  
37 Q: So he's pointing it towards you guys?  
38  
39 A2: Yeah. And I told my mom to get behind something and don't  
40 (unintelligible) any windows because I know (unintelligible).  
41  
42 Q: Sure.  
43

1 A2: And um, (Marketa) - I told (Marketa) to lock the back door one more  
2 time. I said, just go and take the long way, which is through mom's  
3 because you can't really get hit with a bullet that way.  
4  
5 Q: Mm-hm.  
6  
7 A2: That was about it.  
8  
9 Q: Is that going this way, the long way?  
10  
11 A2: That's my room, (Marketa)'s room.  
12  
13 Q: Okay.  
14  
15 A2: You go through the middle, go through my mom's room and go  
16 through her bathroom and to the right and it's a back door. Walk in, get  
17 down (unintelligible). Me and my mom are like right here.  
18  
19 Q: So...  
20  
21 A2: I went (unintelligible) like this and opened the back door to see what  
22 was going on.  
23  
24 Q: So the last time you saw him he was already in your front yard  
25 pointing a gun at you. You said lock up, shut the doors, lock  
26 everything down. Then he left and you never saw him again?  
27  
28 A2: I was going to come in here and look but...  
29  
30 Q: Can you remember any specific statements he was saying as he was  
31 walking around with the gun in his hand?  
32  
33 A2: Just that I'm going to start counting, start counting, start counting.  
34  
35 Q: Did he start counting?  
36  
37 A2: (Unintelligible).  
38  
39 Q: What did he say? Excuse me, like I'm going to count to five or?  
40  
41 A2: No, he just started counting. He was like one, like after he pointed  
42 (unintelligible) he went to three I closed my eyes.  
43  
44 Q: Were you in there when he started counting? So you watched him the  
45 whole time?

1  
2 A2: Uh-huh. I seen like the whole thing except for the part where he and  
3 my sister got into a tussle. (Unintelligible) came around the corner and  
4 hopped over the (unintelligible) the kitchen. And he got to that  
5 situation.  
6  
7 Q: Mm-hm. How did ah, how did Russell look to you? How did he  
8 sound? Did he..  
9  
10 A2: He sound - it's usually as soon as he sees me, oh hi, how are you  
11 doing, how are you doing. (Unintelligible).  
12  
13 Q: Right.  
14  
15 A2: He didn't care.  
16  
17 Q: Did he sound like he (unintelligible) anything tonight?  
18  
19 A2: He had like (unintelligible) but he wasn't the same person.  
20  
21 Q: Okay. He wasn't the same person in your - in your eyes.  
22  
23 A2: Mm-hm.  
24  
25 Q: Did he appear to be on any drugs or alcohol that you can tell?  
26  
27 A2: Uh-uh.  
28  
29 Q: Okay.  
30  
31 A2: I know like his breath smelled real bad like alcohol.  
32  
33 Q: You were close enough to smell that? Did he make any...  
34  
35 A2: When he walked by me, I was like, oh.  
36  
37 Q: So when he walked by, he didn't make any threats directed at you or  
38 anybody? He was just kind of in a daze walking through the house?  
39  
40 A2: Oh, I forgot that like towards the middle - I forgot. He went to my  
41 mom's room and kind of trashed the drawers.  
42  
43 Q: Drawers?  
44  
45 A2: Yeah, her clothes, like he went looking for his keys.

2 Q: Okay.

3

4 A2: So I move out of the way. He held the gun like this while he was going  
5 through the drawers like then he started throwing stuff. That was about  
6 it sir.

7

8 Q: Okay. And you've known him how long?

9

10 A2: I met him last year's Christmas. No I met him before Christmas when  
11 they were just boyfriend and girlfriend.

12

13 Q: Okay.

14

15 A2: We went bowling.

16

17 Q: Do you remember when they got married?

18

19 A2: Ah, no I wasn't here for that.

20

21 Q: Do you know where they got married or anything about your mom's  
22 marriage?

23

24 A2: I wanted to go to their marriage but it was just between those two I  
25 guess.

26

27 Q: Okay. Can you think of anything else that ah, you remember right  
28 now? Anything I haven't asked that you want to tell me more about  
29 anything?

30

31 A2: No, just you probably (unintelligible) I guess, I thought he was okay  
32 but then when we all sort of get like attached to him a little, because  
33 like I'm not going to lie. He was cool at the time. So I was like oh,  
34 (unintelligible) this guy (unintelligible) is okay, but as soon as you get  
35 attached to him like he (unintelligible). There goes another one.

36

37 Q: Okay. So tonight the very first time you heard or saw him, what were  
38 you doing? Were you sitting on the couch?

39

40 A2: I was playing Guitar Hero.

41

42 Q: So you're playing Guitar Hero and your mom hears something?

43

44 A2: Mm-hm. She's like - she says Russell is in the green truck. I look out  
45 the window and...

2 Q: Did she see this through an open door or through a window?  
3  
4 A2: Ah, through the door.  
5  
6 Q: So she had opened the door?  
7  
8 A2: (Unintelligible) we keep the white door open and the black door you  
9 can just see right out of it.  
10  
11 Q: Okay. So she - does she open the black door and look out?  
12  
13 A2: No. She just says, Russell, get out of the car.  
14  
15 Q: Through the screen?  
16  
17 A2: Yeah.  
18  
19 Q: But the first thing you heard, you're playing Guitar Hero. All of a  
20 sudden your mom says Russell get out of the truck?  
21  
22 A2: Mm-hm.  
23  
24 Q: Okay. That's what started this whole thing. Did you drop the guitar and  
25 get up and go look?  
26  
27 A2: Mm-hm. And after that just like whoa, like she closed the door. And  
28 I'm about to go like this, because then she said he had a gun. Oh no,  
29 no, no. I tried pulling her inside. But then she said, go lock the back  
30 door. And I just thought about it, and I was like, (Marketa) go lock the  
31 back door? Did you hear that? And I guess she got there and she barely  
32 heard it so it was too late. He got in.  
33  
34 Q: And that's when he was talking to her. Okay, so we need to talk to  
35 (Marketa) and Jeff. And Jeff is (Marketa)'s friend, her boyfriend?  
36  
37 A2: Friend.  
38  
39 Q: Friend? Okay.  
40  
41 A2: And that's it, officer.  
42  
43 Q: Okay. All right. Well thank you. Ah...  
44  
45 A2: You guys haven't seen (Marketa) yet have you?

1  
2 Q: No. Apparently your mom called her. So she should be...  
3  
4 A2: Did she get in contact with her?  
5  
6 Q: You know, I don't know.  
7  
8 A2: I'll call her one more time just to be sure.  
9  
10 Q: Okay. Thanks.  
11  
12 Q1: (Unintelligible) I don't know (unintelligible) relationship but...  
13  
14 Q: Did we ever get a hold of (Marketa)?  
15  
16 A: She's coming (unintelligible).  
17  
18 Q: (Unintelligible). I don't know.  
19  
20 A: (Unintelligible).  
21  
22 Q: (Unintelligible). Um, (unintelligible).  
23  
24 A: (Unintelligible).  
25  
26 Q: I know, (Unintelligible).  
27  
28 A: I already told you (unintelligible).
