On 01-18-09, at 0300 hours, I assisted with the charting and inventory of Officer Taylor's handgun used in this incident. Officer Taylor was also present during the charting. Evidence Technician Sue Lane conducted the charting and took possession of Officer Taylor's handgun.

Handgun details

I witnessed Officer Taylor take his Glock handgun out of his holster and clear the ammunition. He handed the gun to Sue Lane.

Officer Taylor's handgun is a Glock Model 22 40 caliber, serial number [REDACTED]. The handgun magazine holds 15 rounds.

One (1) round was taken from the chamber of the handgun. Twelve (12) rounds were taken from the magazine which was in the gun.

The maximum number of rounds that could be in Officer Taylor's handgun would be sixteen, with one round in the chamber and fifteen rounds in the magazine. Thirteen rounds were taken from Officer Taylor's gun.

Officer Taylor stated that he remembered firing two rounds, and only two casings were found at the scene. Officer Taylor stated that he may have only loaded the magazine with fourteen rounds and had one round in the chamber for a total of fifteen.

Officer Taylor's handgun and magazines were collected as evidence by Sue Lane.

Officer Taylor was given a replacement Glock Model 22. The replacement gun serial number was [REDACTED].

Officer Taylor also had a tactical light on his handgun. The handgun was photographed with the light attached. After the handgun was photographed, Officer Taylor removed the light placed it on his new handgun.
