We drove Code-3 to the location when an Officer broadcast that he had fired shots at a suspect. Upon our arrival we assisted in securing a residence described as belonging to the suspect at 11531 Trailway Drive.  After the scene was secured I was directed to interview two witnesses that were waiting just outside the perimeter at Trailway Drive and Countrydale Drive. W1/Long told me the following:  W1/Long was entering the gates to the community in his vehicle when he noticed a police car stopping near Trailway Drive and Countrydale Drive. The Officer exited his patrol car, drew his handgun, and crossed the street towards the south side of Trailway Drive. about two houses down the street. W1/Long saw a black male wearing a white t-shirt further down the street near a moving truck. The man appeared to be crouched down. W1/Long thought the man was a neighbor he knows as "Virgil."

W1/Long then heard three gunshots, followed quickly by another two shots. W1/Long did not see who fired the shots, nor did he see anyone struck by the gunfire. Upon hearing the gunshots W1/Long quickly drove several houses north on Countrydale Drive to get out of harm's way.

I then spoke to W2/Phong, who told me the following:

W2/Phong was visiting her aunt, who lives at 11531 Streampoint Court. W2/Phong heard a woman screaming in the backyard directly behind the residence, then six or seven gunshots. There was a short pause, then another six or seven shots. A moment later W2/Phong heard muffled gunshots that seemed further away. She could not see anything.

After interviewing witnesses, Sergeant Banks directed me to check all of the patrol cars on scene and turn off any Coban recorders still activated. I turned off the video recorders in units 3907 and 3632 at about 1915 hours.

I assisted with scene security until I was relieved at 2300 hours.
