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**Narrative of Supplemental Report:**

On 11/16/11, at about 0717 hours, I heard a request broadcast over the radio that an officer needed assistance. I heard the location broadcast as the Tyler Springs Apartments (10406 Indiana Ave.). I drove to the location and advised Lieutenant Phillips I was on scene. I offered tactical assistance, since it had been broadcast the suspect had been now barricaded in his apartment and armed with a shotgun.

I began coordinating with patrol supervision and making sure containment and an arrest / emergency response team was in place. Once SWAT personnel began arriving on scene, I began assigning SWAT operators and snipers to take up the containment positions to replace patrol personnel. Additional SWAT operators arrived and I contacted Sgt. Payne to have the SWAT personnel replace the patrol arrest team that he was in charge of.

Once as many patrol personnel as possible were replaced with SWAT operators, I responded to the Technical Services Unit (TSU) trailer. I acted as a liaison between TSU and the SWAT arrest team. TSU had deployed a robot with the intent of entering the suspect apartment. Once the robot was inside, the camera from the robot showed what looked like a male body in dark clothing lying in the hallway. The body was not moving. I relayed the information to the officers on scene and SWAT personnel.

SWAT operators entered the apartment and secured the suspect and location.
