On 03-01-12, at approx. 0233 hours, I responded to Anna and Lincoln reference a foot pursuit. While responding I heard the unit in the foot pursuit broadcast shots fired 11-99. I arrived on scene and Officer Schultz was checking the Police unit where one occupant of the suspect vehicle had been placed in the back seat of the patrol car. I yelled and asked where Officer Lopez was and I heard a voice yell "over here" from South of my location. I ran to a wall and saw Officer Porter standing on the Anna side of the wall. I jumped the wall into the backyard of 2914 Hyde Park where Officer Lopez was holding the suspect at gun point. The suspect was laying face down in the grass just West of a small cinder block planter. I placed the suspect in handcuffs. Once handcuffed, the suspect remained laying face down for only a few seconds. Before I could roll him into a recovery position, he rolled onto his right side, then onto his back kicking his feet saying that he could not breathe. The suspect would roll from his back to his right side and then onto his back again repeatedly. This went on for a couple minutes and he eventually stayed laying on his back.

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**Narrative Continued:**

The suspect remained laying on his back until he was treated at the scene by medical personnel. There was a silver colored firearm (Handle was wrapped in black tape), East of the suspect, against the wall inside the planter. I then located a spent "mushroomed" bullet covered in blood in the grass just West of the suspects feet. I placed an F.I. card over the bullet and informed Sgt. Lambert of the found bullet. Sgt. Lambert had Officer Glover photograph the bullet and the firearm where they were located.

I remained at the scene of the shooting securing the backyard area of 2914 Hyde Park with Officer Glover. At approx. 0533 hours, I was told by Sgt. Lambert to clear with a supplemental report and be available for calls. I remained on scene for approx. 1 hour with Officer Glover after clearing. I cleared the scene at approx. 0630 to handle a radio call.
