Narrative:

On 06-12-2013, 0325 hours, I met with Sergeant Keenan Lambert at the Magnolia Street police station. The interview with Sergeant Lambert was audio recorded using my department issued PUMA recorder. The following is a summary of the interview;

Sergeant Lambert said he was at the Lincoln Station parking lot when he overheard a radio broadcast that Officer Garcia was with a vehicle at Van Buren and the 91 freeway that was possibly related to a traffic collision and a subject having a gun. Sergeant Lambert began to respond to the scene by entering the 91 freeway, westbound from the Adams Street on-ramp. As Sergeant Lambert was approaching the Van Buren off-ramp, he observed a black vehicle that was spun out and facing east and against the north embankment. Sergeant Lambert continued up the Van Buren off-ramp and observed Officer Garcia's police vehicle near a small compact burgundy colored vehicle. The compact burgundy colored vehicle appeared to be high-centered on the Van Buren median. Officer Garcia had the driver detained outside the burgundy vehicle. Sergeant Lambert described the driver of the burgundy vehicle as a black male adult, medium build, about 6'0 tall and weighing about 190 pounds. He believed he was wearing a light colored shirt and jeans.

Sergeant Lambert said as he was assisting Officer Garcia with the driver, he learned via police dispatch that a passenger from the burgundy car was armed with a handgun and was last seen walking towards the Chevron gas station which was directly west from their location. Sergeant Lambert looked towards the Chevron gas station and saw two groups of police officers to the front of the station. One group was near the north-east corner and one group was to the south-east corner. Sergeant Lambert believed the officers were looking for the armed subject. Sergeant Lambert recognized one of the officers near the south-east corner as K-9 Officer Hibbard.

Sergeant Lambert said he saw the suspect the south side of the Chevron station, walking east towards the front of the station. Lambert described the suspect as a black male adult wearing a light colored shirt and shorts. Lambert said it appeared as if the suspect was holding up his shorts near his waistband. Lambert heard the officers yelling commands at the suspect. Lambert could not hear what the commands were. Lambert saw the suspect raise his right hand and point his right hand at the officers. He could not see what was in the suspects hand but believed it was a handgun based on the way he was pointing his hand at the officers. Lambert began hearing multiple gunshots. He believed gunshots were coming from the officers nearest the suspect. He believes he heard 5 to 8 gunshots total. He did not know which officers were firing. Lambert last saw the suspect turn and begin walking away from the officers towards the rear of the building.

After the shooting, Sergeant Lambert went to the Chevron Station to assist with the shooting investigation. It was at that time he learned that Officer Hibbard and Disla were involved in the shooting. Lambert saw the suspect lying on the ground, handcuffed. He said he saw what appeared to be a revolver lying near a dirt planter several feet from the suspect.
