Narrative:

On 06-11-13, at approximately 2330 hours, I was contacted by Detective J. Simons and asked to respond to the area of 3476 Van Buren Boulevard, in the city and county of Riverside, regarding an Officer Involved Shooting investigation.

I arrived at the scene at approximately 0025 hours, and shortly thereafter attended a briefing of the incident provided by Field Operations Lieutenant C. Milby (Watch Commander) and Sergeant R. Tipre.

Following the briefing, Detective R. Wheeler was assigned as the Case Agent and Detective Rick Cobb as the Co-Case Agent. Detective G. Rowe, Forensic Technician T. Ellis and Evidence Technician S. McKay-Davis were assigned to process the crime scene. Detective R. Sanfilippo, Detective M. Medici and Detective J. Simons were assigned to conduct interviews and I, along with Supervising Forensic Technician C. Fuller, responded to the Riverside Police Department, Magnolia Station, to assist with charting Officer Hibbard's and Officer Disla's weapons.

I contacted Officer Hibbard and with the consent of his attorney, John Bakhit, had him meet me in the evidence unit in order for Supervising Forensic Technician C. Fuller to photograph him and chart his duty weapon.

Officer E. Hibbard (#1316)

0246 hours

Supervising Evidence Technician C. Fuller started by taking photographs of Officer Hibbard. Officer Hibbard had no injuries from the incident and no damage to his clothing or gear. Officer Hibbard was wearing his department issued "K-9" BDU uniform, which consists of a pair of black utility pants, black shirt with a cloth badge on the left chest and "K-9" / "E. Hibbard" on the right chest. The shirt also had Riverside Police Department patches on both sleeves. His Sam Browne gear was made of black nylon.

Duty Weapon

Glock .40 caliber (semi-auto) Model 22 Serial# FFY802

The weapon had one (1) round in the chamber and five (5) additional rounds in the magazine, which has a fifteen (15) round maximum capacity. The weapon also has a flashlight attached, which was kept with the firearm when it was collected.

Of the three (3) additional magazines on his duty belt all had a fifteen (15) round capacity and were loaded to full capacity.

Based on the charting of Officer Hibbard's weapon, he fired ten (10) rounds from his duty weapon.

Supervising Forensic Technician C. Fuller took possession of Officer Hibbard's duty weapon, the magazine from the weapon, and the six (6) rounds found in the weapon. Officer Hibbard maintained possession of his additional magazines. Sergeant Russell provided Officer Hibbard another weapon and attachable flashlight.

Officer C. Disla (#1499)

Supervising Forensic Technician C. Fuller started by taking photographs of Officer Disla. Officer Disla had no injuries from the incident and no damage to his clothing or gear. Officer Disla was wearing a full Riverside Police Department uniform, with his badge on the left chest, name tag over the right shirt pocket and department patches on both sleeves. He was wearing a leather Sam Browne duty belt.

Patrol Rifle

Smith & Wesson .556mm Model M&P Serial# 05402

The weapon had one (1) round in the chamber and twenty-one (21) additional rounds in the magazine, which has a thirty (30) round capacity. Rather than loading the magazines to capacity, Officer Disla only loads his magazine with twenty-eight (28) rounds. Officer Disla told me during a recent training day he fired one round from a magazine but did not replace it, so one of his magazines only had twenty-seven (27) rounds in it.

Officer Disla had one additional magazine for his patrol rifle, which was loaded with twenty-eight (28) rounds.

Based on the charting of this weapon, Officer Disla fired five (5) rounds from his patrol rifle.

Duty Weapon

HK .40 caliber (semi-auto) Model USP Serial# 22-104656

The weapon had one (1) round in the chamber and thirteen (13) additional rounds in the magazine, which has a thirteen (13) round maximum capacity. The weapon also has a flashlight attached.

The two (2) additional magazines from the magazine pouch were also thirteen (13) round capacity. One of the magazines was loaded to capacity and the other had twelve (12) rounds in it. Officer Disla was not aware the one magazine was not loaded to capacity.

Back-Up Weapon

Smith & Wesson .38 (revolver) Model 340PD Serial# DAV3887

Officer Disla carries the above back-up weapon in his right rear pants pocket. The weapon is a five (5) shot revolver, which was loaded to capacity with .38 Special +P rounds. There were no expended casings in this weapon.

Based on the charting of Officer Disla's weapons he did not fire any rounds from the magazine that was in his duty weapon, nor did he fire any rounds from his back up weapon.

Officer Disla kept possession of both his weapons.
