



Fire Prevention

City of Riverside Fire Department Recreation/Ceremonial Fires

1. Before and after burning (totally extinguishing fire), contact Police/Fire dispatch at (951) 787-7911 and let them know you are going to have a recreational fire.
2. Recreational fires shall not be conducted within 25 feet of a structure or combustible material unless contained in a barbecue pit. Conditions, which could cause a fire to spread to within 25 feet of a structure, shall be eliminated prior to ignition.
3. Buckets, shovels, garden hoses or a water type fire extinguisher shall be readily available for use at recreational fires.
4. A person knowledgeable in the use of fire-extinguishing equipment shall constantly attend recreational fires. An attendant shall supervise a recreational fire until such fire has been extinguished.
5. BBQ pits outside of buildings shall not be located within 15 feet of a structure.

The Fire Department is authorized to require that recreational fires be immediately discontinued if such fires are determined to constitute a hazardous condition.

These requirements are in accordance with the California Fire Code Section 307.4.2 2007

Note: Recreational fires are not to be wider than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet high.
