Firefighter Requirements

- Completion of the twelfth grade **OR** equivalent
- Completion of a California State Fire Marshal accredited Fire Academy **OR** two years of full-time paid experience as a Firefighter with a municipal department
- Possession of a valid class "C" California Motor Vehicle Operator's License
- Possession of a valid American Heart Association Health Care Provider **OR** Red Cross Professional Rescuers Certification
- Possession of a valid Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) card **OR** Possession of a valid paramedic license at the time of application. Candidates must provide proof of a valid California State EMT certification or paramedic license prior to the first day of employment.
- Possession of a certified candidate (CPAT) certificate **OR** Biddle physical agility test certificate within six months of application.
