### CURRENT SITUATION

City of Riverside Fire Department units responded to a traffic accident near a large construction site in the area of the West Bound 60 Freeway at Box Springs. The victim of a traffic accident walked from the vehicle accident and fell into a deep hole at the construction site. The victim was able to direct Fire and EMS units to his location using a cell phone. The victim was found in a large trench that was 12 feet wide by 18 feet deep. The Tech Rescue Team, with the support of the units on scene, rendered aid and removed the victim from the trench. The victim was transport to an area hospital for further medical treatment.
