### CURRENT SITUATION

Riverside Fire units responded to a reported structure fire in an apartment complex. Fire crews arrived on scene and reported heavy smoke visible from the street and initiated fire attack. Additional resources arrived on scene, assisted in extinguishment, search of the apartments for possible victims, and ventilation operations. The fire was under control within eight minutes of the first arriving unit and there were no reported injuries to civilians or firefighters. The cause of the fire was determined to be Accidental. A child was playing with an uncovered electrical outlet near his bed when he said it sparked and caught the bedding and accumulated papers on fire. He alerted his mother who called 911.
