Each applicant will:

1. Complete Critical Incident Stress awareness training.

 - b. Print the test out and complete it for filing.
2. Complete IS-100 and IS-200(or their equivalent), IS-700 and IS-800B online Courses. **Courses can be accessed on-line at:**

 - a. Please print out all certificates for filing.
3. Complete DHS/FEMA National US&R Response System Orientation course as part of the Task Force orientation.
 - a. Please review PowerPoint.
 - b. Take test and print status report.
4. Review CATF6 Orientation
 - a. Please review PowerPoint.
5. Complete initial training at the First Responder Operation level for Hazardous Materials.
 - a. Complete annual refresher training as required.
 - b. Bring certificate for filing.
6. Be currently certified in CPR.
7. Complete respiratory protection training.
 - a. Complete refresher training as required for respiratory protection.

This depends on the amount of additional training that is required for the position.
