

- Plant pests and diseases, and methods of their control and eradication.
- Skilled construction and repair methods, including carpentry, pipe fitting, painting and cement work.
- Safe work practices.
- Principles of supervision and training.

Ability to:

- Lead skilled maintenance personnel in the performance of park construction, maintenance and repair tasks.
- Perform highly skilled park construction, maintenance and repair tasks.
- Operate a variety of equipment used in park maintenance.
- Read and interpret construction plans and specifications.
- Understand and carry out oral and written directions.
- Supervise and train subordinates.
- Work overtime as scheduled.

Education and Experience:

Any combination of experience and education that would likely provide the required knowledge and abilities is qualifying. A typical way to obtain the knowledge and abilities would be:

Education: Equivalent to the completion of the twelfth grade. Additional training in park construction, maintenance and repair is highly desirable.

Experience: Four years of increasingly responsible experience in park or grounds maintenance, which includes but is not limited to the following fields: carpentry, electrical welding, concrete, plumbing and large irrigation systems.

Possession of an appropriate, valid class "C" California Motor Vehicle Operator's License.
