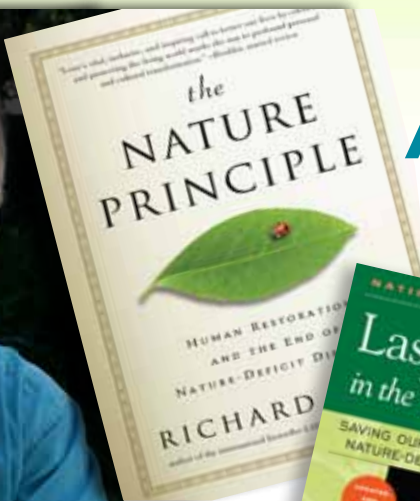
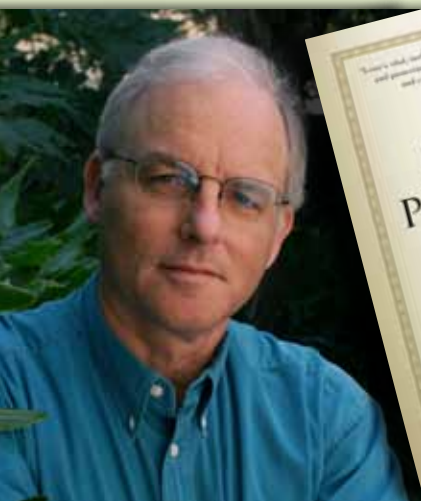


What is Nature-Deficit Disorder?
