Van Buren Boulevard construction



This project is the third of five phases to improve Van Buren Boulevard from the Santa Ana River north to the southerly City limit.

This \$35 million project widens the bridge over the Riverside (91) Freeway to six lanes with dual left turn lanes. The westbound on and offramps are being widened to three lanes. A new eastbound onramp is being constructed on Indiana Avenue. The project limits extend from Andrew Street/Primrose Avenue to the north, Indiana Avenue to the south and approximately 5,000 feet along Riverside Freeway.

Not only do these changes make access to the Riverside Freeway faster and easier, but this project beautifies the interchange by building new retaining walls and using water-wise plants in the landscaping.
