


# Five Points Street Widening Project



The Five Points Street Widening Project is currently out to bid to realign and improve the intersection of La Sierra Avenue, Pierce Street, Hole Avenue and Bushnell Avenue, known as “Five Points.” The street alignment was proposed to meet transportation demands, improve safety, and enhance the aesthetics of the area. The Project includes two through lanes, two left-turn lanes, a dedicated right-turn lane, and a Class II bike lane in each direction, separated by a raised and landscaped median.

The Project will improve the aesthetics of the area by the addition of decorative crosswalks, landscaped parkways, and a publicly maintained landscaped area on the southeast corner of La Sierra and Hole Avenues. Bushnell Avenue will be closed to vehicular traffic at La Sierra Avenue to facilitate the realignment of the intersection and improve traffic circulation.

The Project is scheduled to start in October 2010, with the completion of the building demolitions, followed by the street construction phase. The Project is estimated to take approximately five months to complete.
