

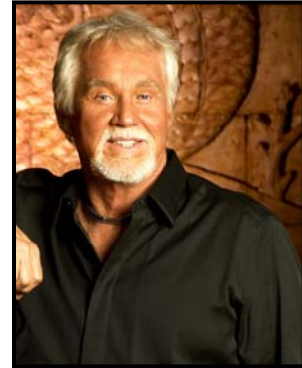

KENNY ROGERS ADDS THE FOX TO HIS TOUR SCHEDULE

RIVERSIDE, Calif. – Country and pop music icon Kenny Rogers is coming to the Fox Performing Arts Center on Saturday, May 1 at 8 p.m.

Kenny Rogers has amassed one of the most impressive recording careers across all genres, selling more than 105 million records worldwide and becoming the 8th best-selling male recording artist of all time. With such beloved hits as “Lady,” “Ruby Don’t Take Your Love to Town,” “The Gambler,” “She Believes in Me,” “We’ve Got Tonight” and “Islands in the Stream,” his #1 smash duet with Dolly Parton, Rogers has enjoyed unparalleled success in both country and pop. He has also become known and respected as an actor on TV and in movies, including his starring role in the TV miniseries based on his hit song, “The Gambler.”

The Fox Performing Arts Center is one of Riverside’s most revered landmarks. The Fox opened in 1929 as a cinema/vaudeville theater house and attracted well-known performers including Bing Crosby and Judy Garland. Additionally, it became popular as a location for motion picture previews, the theater is most known as the site of the first public screening of “Gone with the Wind.” In January 2010, after two years of restoration, the City re-opened the Fox as a 1642-seat state-of-the-art performing arts center for Riverside and the Inland Empire.
