RIVERSIDE FAIRMOUNT GOLF COURSE TEMPORARILY CLOSES

RIVERSIDE, Calif. – The City of Riverside announced today that the Riverside Fairmount Golf Course has been closed temporarily. The decision follows a court ruling that the existing operator of the golf course was unable meet its lease obligation to pay the rent. As a result of the court's decision, the City of Riverside will assume the maintenance and operation of the golf course.

The City is committed to providing quality recreational services to residents. It is anticipated that the golf course will remain closed for 60-90 days to complete renovations to the course and driving range. During this time, the City's Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department will develop an implementation plan to assume the day-to-day maintenance and operation of the golf course. This plan will include enhanced landscape maintenance and operations of the pro shop, driving range and concessions.
