What is it? “Spay-it-Forward” is a campaign focused on combating pet overpopulation in the City of Riverside and neighboring communities through subsidized services.

Who is eligible: Any individual who ...

- owns an unaltered Cat, Pit Bull, Pit Bull “mix”, Chihuahua, Chihuahua “mix” or any puppy or kitten under six (6) months of age*, and
- meets income qualification levels, and
- can prove residence in zip code **92501** or **92509** by providing a current utility bill.

Services Received: “Spay-it-Forward” cats will receive spay/neuter surgery and rabies vaccination.

“Spay-it-Forward” dogs will receive spay/neuter surgery, rabies vaccination and microchip with chip registration.
