Christmas Tree Recycling

*Christmas trees are collected with the normal
trash pick-up between Dec. 27, 2016 and Jan. 13,
2017. Please follow these procedures for proper
disposal of your tree:*

- Remove the stand, ornaments and decorations
- Cut your tree into 4 foot lengths and place in
your green container or place on the curb next
to your green container
- Flocked trees are not greenwaste and should
be cut into 4 foot lengths and placed in or next
to the brown container on the curb
- If tree is placed in green or brown container,
the lid of the container must close in order to
receive service
