SUBJECT: **Discharge of Wastewater from Service Bays, or
Vehicle/Equipment Washing**
R.M.C., Chapter 14.12.250

All companies discharging wastewater generated from the washing of service bays or vehicle/equipment washing, must have the area(s) connected to a properly sized sand/oil interceptor. If a company has service bays and does not install trench drains and a properly installed sand/oil interceptor, the company will not be permitted to liquid wash the floor area that would result in the wastewater being discharged outside the building.

A company not desiring to wash the service bay floors or vehicles/equipment, **must submit a letter to the Environmental Compliance Section**, (on company letterhead), stating the company will not use any liquid processes to wash the service bay floors, or vehicles/equipment, which would result in the wastewater being discharged beyond the interior of the building.
