

Christmas Tree Recycling

Christmas trees are collected with the normal trash pick-up between Dec. 26, 2013 and Jan. 17, 2014. Please follow these procedures for proper disposal of your tree:

- Remove the stand, ornaments and decorations
- Cut your tree into 4 foot lengths
- Place on the curb next to your green container
- Flocked trees are not greenwaste and should be placed next to the brown container

Please DO NOT place Christmas trees in your greenwaste container
