

Notice of Refuse Rate Adjustment for Fiscal Year 2014-15

The City of Riverside adopted a multi-year refuse rate plan on February 12, 2013. The plan includes annual adjustments based upon the Consumer Price Index as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the US Department of Labor, and refuse disposal fee and greenwaste processing fee per ton as set by the Riverside County Waste Management Department and Agua Mansa Material Recovery Facility (MRF).

The City of Riverside's goal is to provide a comprehensive solid waste management and recycling program strategy to provide for the health, welfare and sustainability of our community. This is achieved through programs such as CURE by providing services to encourage recycling and discourage illegal dumping, keeping Riverside clean and beautiful.

In addition to weekly refuse, green waste, and recyclable materials collection services, CURE offers many free services to City residents including:

- Bulky item and e-waste drop-off events
- Residential curbside bulky item pickups
- Curbside appliance and used oil pickup
- Household hazardous waste drop-off
- Free bulky item drop-off every third Saturday of the month
- Free or low cost mulch for City residents and businesses

Through our programs the City now has 67.4% of its waste recycled.

The City of Riverside's goal is to increase recycling in Riverside to 75% by 2020.

The following monthly refuse rates will be effective beginning July 1, 2014.

RESIDENTIAL


On February 12, 2013, the City Council approved a five-year Refuse Rate Plan for residential rate increases. The increase is based on a Consumer Price Index of 1.14%.
