

CITY OF RIVERSIDE DOG LICENSE AMNESTY PROGRAM

JULY – AUGUST 2010



The City of Riverside is promoting a Dog License Amnesty Program. All late fees and past due dog license amounts will be waived during July and August. **Additionally, dog owners will receive a one year credit for an altered and microchipped dog (proof required).**

Rabies vaccinations and dog licenses are required for all dogs four months and older in the City of Riverside. Not only does dog licensing make it easier to reunite lost pets with owners, but it is also the key to rabies control. Current rabies vaccinations for dogs are crucial to protect your dog and the public from rabies. (See reverse for special low-cost vaccination clinic information.)

Current City license fees are as follows:

	1 year	2 year	3 year
Unaltered Dog	\$100.00	\$175.00	\$250.00
Spayed/Neutered Dog	\$16.00	\$25.00	\$35.00
Senior Dog Owner (60+) (Spayed/Neutered Dog)	\$10.00	\$15.00	\$20.00

Proof of a current rabies vaccination, sterilization and the microchip are all that are required to purchase a license. Licensing is available at:



Rabies	\$6.00
FVRCP (feline influenza, calicivirus, feline distemper)	\$15.00

Microchip Fees:

Dog or Cat (includes registration and lifetime monitoring) \$28.00
