

Learn more about the police department by participating in the Citizen Academy.

The 10 week course is designed to give citizens an overview of the department's functions, encourage participation in a police-community partnership, and promote open lines of communication to develop lasting relationships. Each week volunteer jobs are highlighted so participants can determine what volunteer job may be right for them. Classes are offered twice a year... check our website for more information.

ADMINISTRATIVE GROUPS

Work inside a police facility. Assignments such as data entry, answering phones, filing, and general office duties.

CITIZEN PATROL GROUPS

Extra eyes and ears for our officers. COP has four groups; Vehicle Patrol, Mounted Posse, Bike Patrol, and Foot Patrol.

SPECIAL DETAIL GROUPS

Work at special and community events and programs; DUI Checkpoints, 911 for Kids, car seat fitting stations, station tours, OWE, and the You Are Not Alone Program.

SPECIALIZED GROUPS

Chaplains, TSU, Traffic follow-up, and Range. These assignments are very limited in availability.
