### Three Die During Early Morning Attack

**Riverside, CA** – On Thursday, August 30, 2012, at 6:48 AM, officers from the Riverside Police Department responded to a residence in the 10400 block of Granger Street for an unknown trouble call. While officers were responding, the Riverside Police Communications Center received updates that victims had been stabbed at the location. When officers arrived at the location they discovered an adult female and two young children suffering from multiple stab wounds. Officers initiated life saving measures and personnel from the Riverside Fire Department and American Medical Response arrived and continued life saving measures. All three victims were transported to local area hospitals where they were pronounced deceased from their wounds.

Officers at the location obtained the suspect's description as well as the description of the vehicle he fled the scene in. This information was provided to surrounding agencies. At approximately 7:10 AM the suspects' vehicle was located abandoned in the area of the 91 and 15 freeway interchange. Officers from the Corona Police Department were directed to the area the suspect was last seen and while attempting to contact the suspect an officer involved shooting occurred. The suspect, Chajon, Selvin, Rodriguez, a 23 year old Riverside resident was transported to a local area hospital where he is listed in critical, but stable condition.

Detectives from the Riverside Police Department Robbery Homicide Unit along with personnel from the Forensic unit responded to the location on Granger to investigate the multiple homicide scene. The officer involved shooting that occurred in the City of Corona will be investigated by personnel from the Corona Police Department.
