Body Found in Field is Identified as Missing Woman

Riverside, CA – On Sunday, September 23, 2012, officers from the Riverside Police Department responded to a residence in the 4300 block of Hillside Street reference a report of a missing female adult. A mother was reporting her adult daughter as a missing person and advised she had not had contact with her daughter since September 9, 2012.

On Saturday, October 13, 2012, a body was found in a field near Jurupa and Tyler in Riverside. That body was identified late last night by the Riverside County Coroner's Office as that of **Kimberly Lynn Dow**, 30, of Riverside, the missing woman. Ms. Dow's death has been determined to be the result of homicide.

Up until her disappearance, Ms. Dow had been living with her boyfriend, **Thomas James Fulk**, 35, of Riverside (see attached photograph), at Fulk's father's residence in the 2800 block of Irving in the City of Riverside. Detectives have been attempting to contact Mr. Fulk for questioning in regard to Ms. Dow's disappearance and now her murder. Mr. Fulk has been actively avoiding contact by law enforcement. The Riverside Superior Court issued an arrest warrant for Mr. Fulk for violation of probation on two unrelated cases for failure to report to the Riverside County Probation Department. These warrants were issued on October 5, 2012.

Detectives from the Robbery / Homicide Unit are involved in the investigation and have been actively working this case since her disappearance.

Detectives are requesting anyone who may have information regarding the whereabouts of Thomas James Fulk, to contact Detective Jim Simons at 951-353-7138 or Detective Jim Brandt at 951-353-7137, or the Dispatch Center at 951-787-7911. Mr. Fulk should be considered armed and dangerous and the public should not attempt to contact him and are asked to call police if he is seen.
