Shooting Victim Dies from Wounds

Riverside, CA – On January 17, 2013, at approximately 0010 hours, the Riverside Police Department Communication Center received a call for a male subject who had been shot in his vehicle in the 3500 block of Franklin. Patrol officers responded and located the subject suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Officers began life saving measures for the victim. Personnel from the Riverside Fire Department responded and transported the subject to a local area hospital where he was initially listed in critical, but stable condition. Later in the evening on January 17, 2013, the victim died from his wounds.

Based on preliminary investigation, it appears the victim was in his vehicle preparing to leave for work. The suspect approached the vehicle and fired an undetermined number of rounds into the vehicle striking the victim. The motive for this shooting is unknown. There is no suspect description at this time and it is unknown if the suspect fled the location on foot or if a vehicle was used to flee.

The name of the victim will be released by the Coroner's Office pending notification to next of kin.
