## Riverside Police Host Child Passenger Safety Clinic

*4 out of 5 car seats are used incorrectly...is yours one of them?*

**Riverside, California:** Motor vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death among children in the United States, in an effort to respond to this problem the Riverside Police Department has partnered with Riverside County Injury Prevention Services, and Inland Empire Safe Kids host a community Child Passenger Safety Clinic.

Parents and caregivers will have the opportunity to get their child's car seat checked by certified technicians. Child restraints will be checked for proper usage, proper fit for the child, and any recalls.

- For the best protection always place your child in a rear-facing child safety seat for as long as possible.
- Be certain that your child's car seat is properly installed to maximize safety and reduce injuries.
