Peace Officers' Memorial Ceremony

Two names of officers who died serving Riverside County to be added to monument during ceremony in Riverside on Monday, May 19, 2014.

Riverside, CA -- Riverside County law enforcement agencies and surviving family members will remember those peace officers who have died in the line of duty at a solemn ceremony at the "Safe in His Arms" memorial statue, at 4102 Orange St., in Riverside, beginning promptly at 6:15 p.m. The public is invited to attend.

The ceremony, steeped in police service traditions, recognizes those who died in service prior to 2014. The names of one Riverside Police Officer and one California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation Officer, both who died in the line of duty in 2013, will be added to the memorial monument this year.

On February 7, 2013, in the early morning hours, Police Officer Michael Crain was shot and killed when he and his partner were ambushed while stopped at a red light. A subject opened fire on their patrol car, fatally wounding Officer Crain and severely wounding his partner.

On March 25, 2013, Correctional Officer Gilbert Cortez and K-9 Mattie, assigned to CDCR-Norco, were killed in an automobile accident on Route 79, near San Felipe Road, in San Diego County. His marked law enforcement vehicle veered off the roadway and overturned, fatally injuring Officer Cortez and his K-9.

Senior law enforcement officials taking part include: Master of Ceremonies U.S. Border Patrol Commander Walter Davenport, Riverside Police Department Chief Sergio G. Diaz, California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (Norco) Warden Cynthia Tampkins and Riverside County Sheriff Stan Sniff.

The names of the two fallen officers will join twenty-one Riverside County Sheriff's Deputies, fifteen Riverside Police Officers, nine California Highway Patrol Officers, eight United States Border Patrol Agents, two Palm Springs Police Officers, two Cathedral City Police Officers, and one each from the Corona Police Department, California Bureau of Narcotics Enforcement and Union Pacific Railroad Police Department.

There will be free parking available in the parking structures located at 3535 12th Street and 4080 Lemon Street.
