## **HIT AND RUN TRAFFIC COLLISION**

RIVERSIDE, CA – On August 10, 2014, at approximately 2:00 AM, Riverside Police and Fire personnel responded to a report of a vehicle vs. bicycle collision near the intersection of Magnolia Ave and Beechwood Pl. A 27 year old Riverside resident was riding his bicycle in the area when a vehicle, travelling North on Magnolia Ave, struck the bicyclist in the number 2 traffic lane. Following the collision, the vehicle failed to stop and was last seen continuing North on Magnolia Ave. The victim was transported to Riverside Community Hospital, by paramedics, with significant injuries. Witnesses described the suspect vehicle as a late model, silver or beige, 4-door SUV, similar to a Ford Flex in appearance. The vehicle sustained significant damage to the front end and windshield,

The Riverside Police Department MAIT responded and is currently investigating the collision.
