### STOLEN PROPERTY RECOVERED DURING SEARCH WARRANT

RIVERSIDE, CA – On August 27, 2014, the Riverside Police Department's Metro Team served a search warrant in the 8600 block of Indiana Ave. The warrant was written in response to an on-going investigation related to credit card fraud and fraudulent merchandise that was delivered to the home on Indiana Ave. Riverside Police Department Economic Crimes Unit recovered evidence and property that was believed to have been purchased using the victim's compromised American Express Card. Over \$3000.00 in stolen property was recovered at the location. In addition to the stolen property recovered, over 2 ounces of methamphetamine was located inside a detached home in the rear yard. Five adults were arrested for various felony charges including possession of stolen property, credit card fraud and possession of narcotics for sale. One of the adults was on Post Release Community Supervision (PRCS), which is an early prison release program enacted by the State of California to reduce prison populations. The following were booked into the Riverside County Jail:

1. Ruben Santoscoy - 42 years old, from Riverside.
2. Diego Cortez – 18 years old, from Riverside
3. Chad Davis - 21 years old, from Riverside
4. Carl Lewis – 50 years old, from Riverside
5. Arlene Anguiano – 32 years old, from Riverside. (PRCS.)
