### **STOLEN PROPERTY RECOVERED DURING SEARCH WARRANT**

RIVERSIDE, CA – On August 29, 2014, the Riverside Police Department's West Neighborhood Policing Center Detectives served a search warrant in the 3100 block of Huckleberry Drive in the City of Corona. The warrant was written in response to an on-going investigation related to an embezzlement investigation involving an Assistant Sales Manager for the Nordstrom retail store located at the Galleria at Tyler in the City of Riverside. An estimated loss of \$9500 was reported by Nordstrom's to have occurred over a two month period. Riverside Police Department West Neighborhood Policing Center Detectives recovered evidence and property that was believed to have been purchased using Nordstrom gift cards that were fraudulently obtained by the employee. Over \$15,000.00 in stolen property was recovered at the location. In addition to the stolen property recovered at the residence, \$800 of property obtained fraudulently was located inside of a storage unit in the City of Corona. Jenny Chang Phongsy of Corona was arrested for various felony charges including embezzlement, grand theft, and possession of stolen property. She was booked into the Riverside County Jail.
