JEWELRY STORE ROBBED – VIDEO AVAILABLE

RIVERSIDE, CA – On Wednesday, September 3, 2014, at about 7:40pm, Riverside Police Department officers responded to an armed robbery at the Kevin Jewelers located inside the Galleria at Tyler. The suspect entered the store posing as a customer. During the encounter the suspect removed a small handgun from his rear pants pocket and pointed it at the employee. He demanded she remove some jewelry from the glass display. He threatened her and told her to turn around. He then left with the jewelry. No vehicle was seen.

The suspected is described as a white male, 50's, 5'06", 160lbs, clean shaven with grey hair. He was last seen wearing a tan long sleeve collared pullover, dark jeans, tan "newsboy" hat, and clear lens glasses. Video is available on our Facebook page at www.facebook.com/RiversidePD.
