MAN SHOT TO DEATH AT PARTY

RIVERSIDE, CA – Riverside Police officers and medical personnel from the Fire Department and American Medical Response (AMR) responded to a report of a shooting at a residence on the 8400 block of Gramercy Place. The call was received at 0140 hours. Upon arrival, medical personnel determined the person shot, a 31 year old male, was deceased. There were no other injuries. The suspect fled prior to the officers' arrival.

Detectives from the Robbery/Homicide Unit and a technician from the Forensic Unit responded and assumed the investigation. Detectives learned there was a party going on at the residence prior to the shooting. It was attended by about 15 people. The investigation is ongoing and detectives are currently interviewing witnesses. Information about the suspect's identity is being withheld at this time due to the ongoing investigation. The Riverside County Sheriff-Coroner's Office will release the victim's name after next of kin are notified.
