

## HOMICIDE SUSPECT IDENTIFIED



**CESAR IVAN LUNA**

RIVERSIDE, CA – Riverside Police officers and medical personnel from the Fire Department and American Medical Response (AMR) responded to a report of a shooting at a residence on the 8400 block of Gramercy Place. The call was received at 0140 hours on Sunday morning. Upon arrival, medical personnel determined the person shot, Jose Eloy DelaRosa, 31, of Riverside, was deceased. There were no other injuries. The suspect fled prior to the officers' arrival.



Detectives from the Robbery/Homicide Unit and a technician from the Forensic Unit responded and assumed the investigation. Detectives learned there was a party going on at the residence prior to the shooting. It was attended by about 15 people. There was a dispute between the victim and the suspect at which time the suspect pulled out a gun and shot the victim. The two did know each other and were friends.

The Riverside County District Attorney's Office has filed murder charges on Cesar Ivan Luna, 23, of Riverside. His current whereabouts are unknown.
