Chief Leach announces promotions

RIVERSIDE, CA – Chief Russ Leach is pleased to announce the promotion of Officer Jayson Wood to Detective, and Detective Daniel Warren to Sergeant, effective September 19, 2008.

Sergeant Daniel Warren served as a Navy SEAL prior to joining law enforcement with the Oceanside Police Department in 1999, making the transfer to Riverside three years later. Warren served on Patrol, with the Sniper Team, as Field Training Officer and as a board member and officer representative for the Riverside Police Officers' Association. As a detective, Warren served with the multi-agency Inland Regional Apprehension Team (IRAT), tracking down and arresting some of the Inland regions most wanted criminals. He holds a Bachelor's degree from the University of California-San Diego and a Master's in Criminal Law and Society from the University of California-Irvine. He and his wife, Kellie, have three sons.

Detective Jayson Wood grew up in Azel, Texas, and came to California after service in the United States Marine Corps during the early 1990s. Wood graduated from the Fullerton College Police Academy and joined the Riverside Police Department in 1998. Wood's assignments have included Patrol, Field Training Officer (FTO), Police and Corrections Team (PACT), METRO (SWAT), Sniper Team and, most recently, as the hotel/motel abatement officer in the Special Investigations Bureau, Narcotics Unit. He is pursuing additional studies at California Baptist University. Detective Wood and his wife, Lori, have two sons.

Sgt. Warren and Det. Wood are awaiting their next assignments.
