## ASSAULT AND THEFT SUSPECT ARRESTED


RIVERSIDE, CA – On February 27, 2016, Officers assigned to the Downtown Entertainment District responded to a Grand Theft that had just occurred at 3801 Mission Inn Ave. (Fox Theater). Prior to arriving, the suspect had fled the scene. Officers immediately began an investigation and determined that the suspect drove into the rear dock area of the theater and loaded several boxes of professional lighting equipment into his car. A security guard that attempted to intervene was almost struck by the fleeing suspect's car. Officers conducted additional follow-up investigation and were able to develop a possible suspect name. The investigation was subsequently turned over to North NPC Detectives.

North NPC Detectives continued the investigation and verified that the suspect was 26 year old Nicholas Concha of Riverside. A warrant was obtained for Concha's arrest and he was arrested March 7<sup>th</sup> by Riverside PD Patrol Officers without incident. Concha was booked into the Robert Presley Detention Center for violation of 487 PC – Grand Theft and 245(a)(1) PC – Assault with a deadly weapon.
