VEHICLE TO VEHICLE SHOOTING LEAVES THREE INJURED

RIVERSIDE, CA – On Saturday, April 23, 2016, at approximately 3:30 pm, Riverside Police Department dispatchers received a call from a concerned citizen who was hearing gun shots and two vehicles that appeared to be chasing each other. Patrol Officers from the Riverside Police Department responded to the area of Madison St and Indiana Ave, but were unable to locate any victims or witnesses. Approximately twenty minutes later, the Riverside Community Hospital called the Riverside Police Department and reported three shooting victims arrived at the hospital.

Detectives from the Riverside Police Department's Gang Unit responded to the hospital and they are currently investigating the circumstances that led up to the shooting. The detectives are being assisted by the Riverside Police Department's Forensic Evidence Unit and the case is on-going at this time.
